

Making an Xbox ISO image using ISOMaker

What you'll need:

ISOMaker PC program

Xbox Program or Game files on your PC.

CD or DVD burner.

Burning software. Most any will work if you have made a good ISO image file.

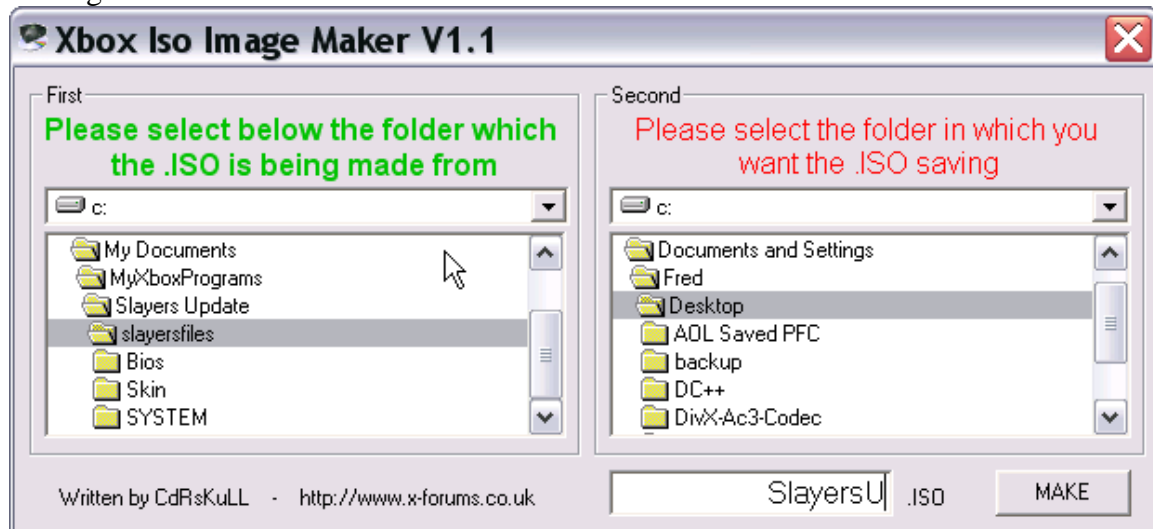
Why ISOMaker when there are newer Apps with more functions?

Basically ISOMaker is the simplest Xbox ISO making App that creates good ISO image files. Once you understand the basics you can choose any Xbox ISO making program depending on your needs. The basics will still be the same.

Open ISOMaker.

The left window is the Source location.

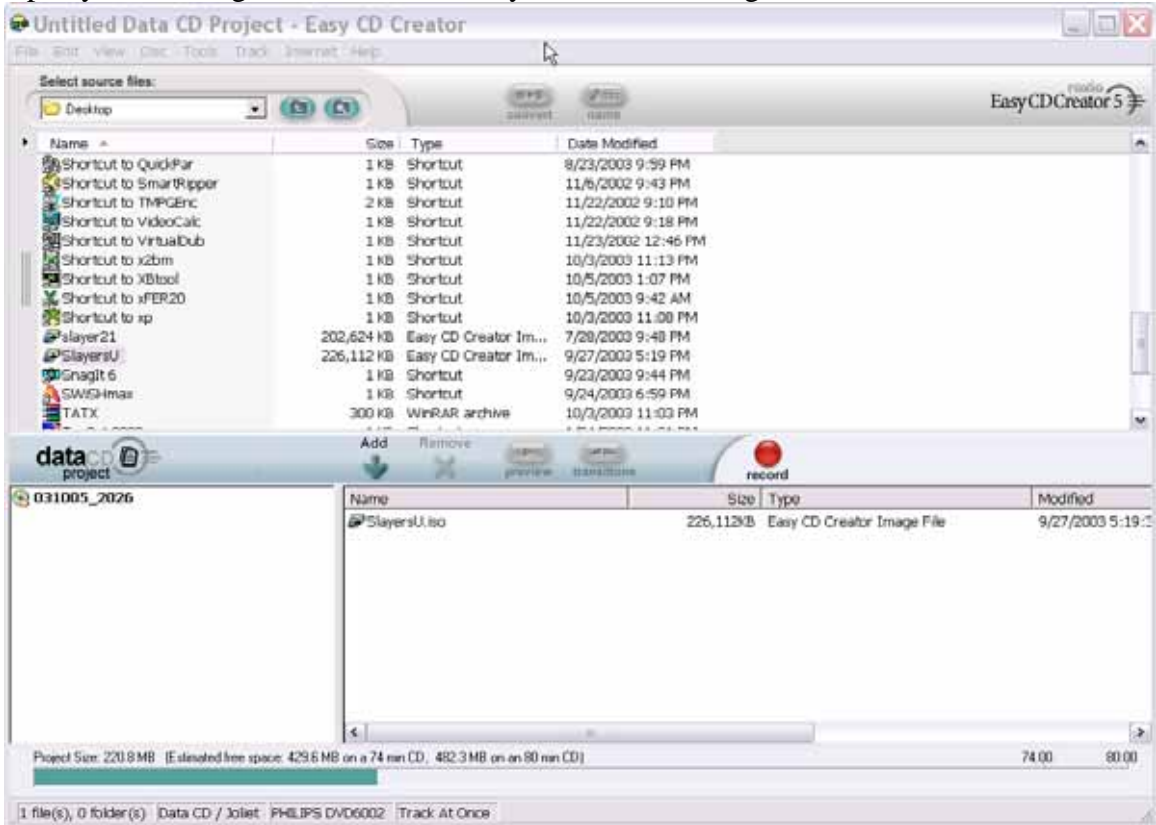
The right window is the Destination location.



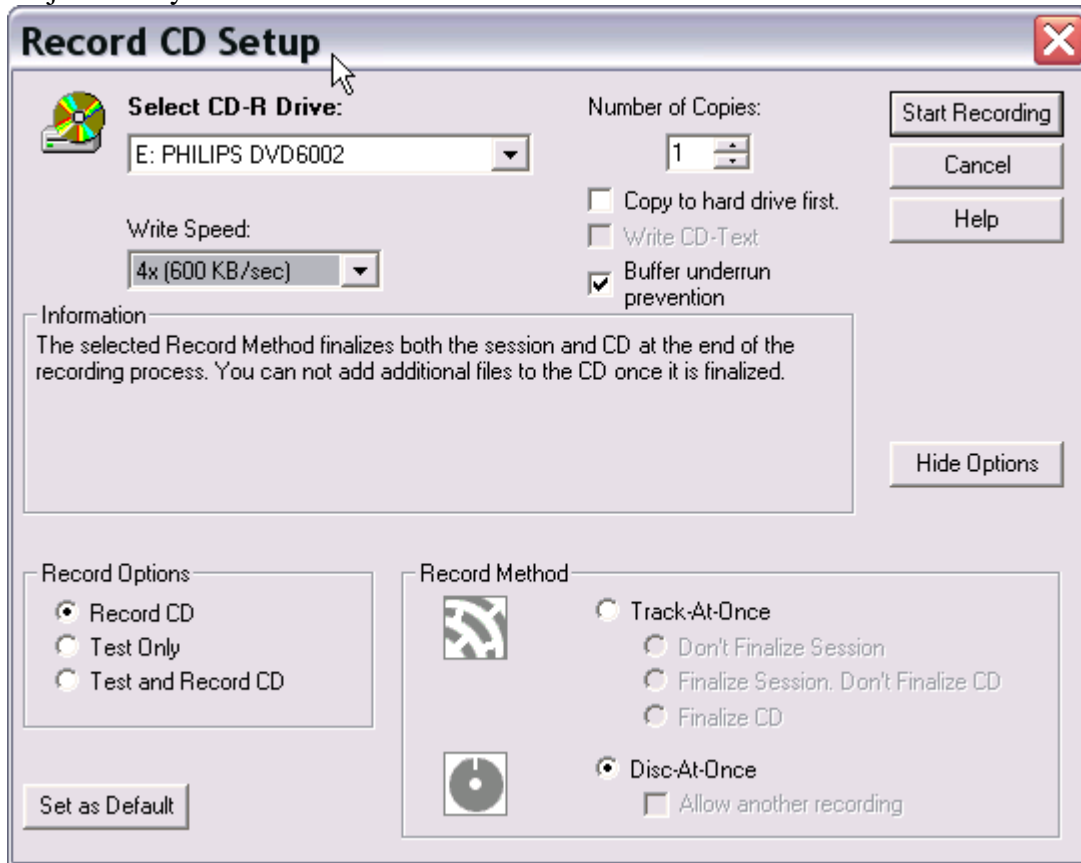
Double click the folder on your PC where your Xbox Files are stored. You will only see the other folders within the Xbox App and not the default.xbe file. This is correct.

In the right window select where on your PC you want the ISO image file stored. Type the name for your ISO image and click Make.

Open your burning software and select your new ISO image file to burn to disc.



Recommended Settings:
Write Speed- no more than 4X speed.
Disc At Once.
Then just burn your ISO to disc.



Recommended CD-RW's are Sony and TDK 4X discs. They seem to load in more Xbox than not. If you have a DVD burner you will have better luck with finding a compatible Brand of disc with your Xbox.
Keep in mind that every Xbox is a little different. Just because a disc will load in one person's Xbox doesn't always mean that the same disc will load in yours.
