

Navigation "Mini Guides" for Various Apps & Emulators

Most Apps & Emulators usually come with some kind of "readme" file that explains what I'm about to lay out here, but sometimes they are difficult to find or in rare cases, don't exist at all. Many even come with an in game/progam help file, but if you are like me and want a handy reference without having to leave the screen you are in, or worse yet, FTP into your Xbox to find a txt file, then this is for you.

This is just a few that I've created from scratch or copied from readme's and consolidated into one document for easy reference. This "mini guide" isn't as comprehensive as I'd like, but it's a start and these are just a few that I've completed. Maybe one day I'll have a complete "mini guide" for everything, but don't hold your breath.

This is a work in progress, so watch for updates & revisions in the future. Also, you may notice slight differences between what I have included here and what your Emu or App does. I can't guarantee that this is perfect, but it's pretty close. A few reasons you might see some differences is either because you are running a different version or I "tweaked" my controls or remapped my buttons (like screenshots, or fast forward) to better suit me.

A	Opens highlighted folder for further browsing. If highlighted item looks like this <..> then pressing "A" while it is highlighted will move you to previous viewed folder. For example: You are browsing F:\Apps\Players. While in "Players" you highlight <..> and press the "A" button. You will now be viewing F:\Apps. If you highlight <..> and press "A" again, you will be viewing the root of F:\.
B	Highlights selected item in red. Pressing "B" allows you to select multiple items. For example: You have 3 folders in F:\ that you want to copy to E:\. Using the "B" button allows you to select all 3 folders to copy. To deselect a folder or item, simply move your cursor to that item and press "B" again.

Action Menu Navigation

DPAD up or down	Moves cursor up or down
A	Selects highlighted item or action.
Back	Exits Action Menu
DPAD up or down	Moves cursor up or down one line
LThumb up or down	Fast scroll up or down

NOTE:

Copying a file or folder will execute without any warning or confirmation.

When deleting a file or folder, a confirmation window/screen will display asking for you to proceed with deletion (Start button) or cancel action (Back button)

When copying, deleting, etc. the item you are executing the action on will be highlighted (white) in the opposite pane/window and will be visible with the Action Menu window open. Make sure that you know where your file is going before copying!

boXplorer

General Navigation

Start	Brings up "Select Drive" menu &/or selects highlighted item.
White	Brings up Action Menu
Black	Exits to Dashboard

DPAD up or down	Moves cursor up or down one line.
LThumb up or down	Fast scroll up or down
DPAD left	Moves cursor down several items (fast jump). Not sure what the logic is to how many items it skips over. May be random.
DPAD right	Moves cursor up several items (fast jump). Not sure what the logic is to how many items it skips over. May be random.
A	Selects highlighted item &/or opens highlighted folder. If the selection highlighted [..], selecting will return you to previous/parent folder.
Y	Moves cursor to top of window/folder
LTrigger	Toggles view from window B to window A. Pressing the LTrigger while in window A does nothing.
RTrigger	Toggles view from window A to window B. Pressing the RTrigger while in window B does nothing.
X	Highlights selected item in blue. Pressing "X" allows you to select multiple items. For example: You have 3 folders in F:\ that you want to copy, or move to E:\. Using the "X" button allows you to select all 3 folders to copy or move. To deselect a folder or item, simply move your cursor to that item and press "X" again.
LThumb click	Toggles view of window A and window B
RThumb click	View filter. (*.*) shows all contents. (*.xbe) shows only .xbe files, (*.wmv) shows only *.wmv files.
